New collection time at the end of 'school' day

To ensure all children get their full early education entitlement, at the end of the 'school' day we're only going to allow access to parents/carers **just before 3.15pm**. Families from Baby Room, Toddler Room and both Nursery classes will no longer be able to gather in the atrium area as the end of the day approaches and must wait outside instead. This stops any children being distracted by their loved ones and also prevents safeguarding concerns with adults having free access to the setting. If you need to pick your child up early, such as for a doctor or dentist appointment, please call ahead and inform us. A similar system is already used for Reception classes so they're not affected by this change, and doesn't apply to extended day children. The new policy begins on **Thursday 23rd November**. Please see Lorna Prynne or Selina Laville with questions.



Transition meetings for children moving rooms

The end of Autumn Term is approaching and many children are moving rooms in January. If your child is one of them, there are meetings organized to discuss the transition process. It's very important you attend one as it'll provide an opportunity to ask questions in anticipation of the big change. You'll also be able to meet staff members who work in your child's new room. 8.30am and 4.00pm. A lot of our families will also be contacted in the coming weeks to provide proof of residence and income, for new contracts. Please just liaise with the admin office to ensure everything is completed before the end of term...

Why toys from home shouldn't be brought in



Unfortunately we can't be responsible if toys from home are broken or lost whilst at Ambler and staff can't spend time with families looking for them. It's impossible to ensure toys from home adhere to health and safety requirements for the wide range of ages we cater to, so please could all parents/carers make sure their child does **not bring any toys from home to the Centre**.

Notification of early closure on last day`

The last day of term is **Wednesday 20th December** and we shall be closing at **2.00pm** for all 'term-time only' children, in line with the primary school. This means there will be no extended day services for Reception children. However, there will still be a reduced child-care service for our 'all year round' families on this day.



We would appreciate it if working and studying parents can collect their children early, preferably by 4pm, so staff can clean the Centre before it closes entirely for the Christmas break. If you expect difficulties on this day please speak to Lorna Prynne or Selina Laville.





Details of special 'Christmas Lunch'

Reading with your Reception child at home


We are offering workshops to Reception parents who would like more information about reading techniques you can use to support your child at home. They're being held on Monday 4th December at 9am and 4pm, as well as on Tuesday 5th December at 2pm. Discussions will be tailored around the actual reading of your particular child so questions can be answered in a more personalised way. 30 hours reminder for Toddler Room children

All children in Toddler Room who are going to be transitioning to Nursery next term should find out now if they are eligible for an additional 15 hours of free childcare after the move. Some families will be able to access up to 30 hours of free childcare a week, rather than the universal 15 hours. Parents can check their eligibility by going to <https://childcare-support.tax.service.gov.uk>



If you are eligible, you'll receive an 11 digit code (called a DERN number). You will then have to complete a form which includes the key details to allow us to verify the code, including your NI number and the child's date of birth. We won't be able to offer any families 30 hours childcare without this form being completed. Before starting your application it is also worth checking out the government's information portal at <https://www.childcarechoices.gov.uk/> to investigate your options on issues like childcare vouchers and tax-free childcare.




Open evening for primary school applications

All children who are currently in Nursery class are due to start primary school next September, so please make sure to apply online before the deadline of **15th January 2018**. It is very important that applications are made on time as otherwise you may miss out on your favoured choice of schools. To do so, Islington residents need to go to www.islington.gov.uk/admissions, while non-Islington

residents should apply directly with their local council.

There is no automatic transfer from our Nursery to our Reception class, even if you already have other siblings in the school. If you are interested in joining the school and want to find out more, our Headteacher is hosting an Open Evening on **Wednesday 13th December at 5pm**, so just let the Children's Centre admin office know that you'd like to attend.




Final Inset day agreed for this academic year
